

How to Use This Passport

The Aston Passport supports your child develop skills in:

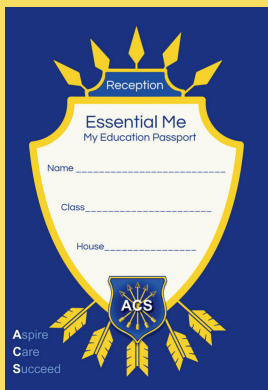
Aiming High

At the end of the academic year children receive the ASTON Award. Depending on how many of the set challenges they've completed throughout the year, they'll be rewarded within one of the following criteria:

Platinum = 5 skills.

Silver = 3 skills

Gold = 4 skills

Bronze = 2 skills

What Are the Challenges?

There are 15 challenges listed **on the back page** designed by the school's House Captains.



Children should complete **1 challenge from each ASTON letter** strand, over the school year – so **5 in total**.

What to do

- Your child picks 1 of the 3 challenges under each letter (A, S, T, O, N).
- Ideally these are done at home, however please speak to your child's teacher if you wish them to complete them at school.
- Before beginning the challenge, help your child fill out the PLAN section in the passport.
- Do the Challenge
- After completing the challenge, help your child fill in the reflection page.
