## Membership terms and conditions

**Please read these carefully and sign the statement to confirm your application.**

<p>Membership is provided on an ongoing, rolling contract and pupils may only withdraw from activities at the end of a term following submission and acceptance of <b>written notice to your local music centre.</b> (Membership will roll over into the new academic year unless cancelled in the summer term.) The notice submission deadlines for each term are available on our website (<a href="http://www.bucksmusic.org">www.bucksmusic.org</a>) but will generally be the last day of the mid-term break. If late notice is received, you will be required to pay a late notice fee in addition to your invoice for the term.</p>		
<p>Fees are invoiced termly and should be paid on receipt of invoice by cheque (payable to Buckinghamshire Music Trust) or by bank transfer to:  <b>Account name:</b> Buckinghamshire Music Trust  <b>Sort code:</b> 30 – 90 – 38      <b>Account number:</b> 61703168  <b>You must ensure that you use the invoice number as a payment reference</b></p>		
<p>Outstanding fees cannot be carried over the end of a term without prior agreement from the music trust central team and may result in tuition or membership services being withdrawn until the account is cleared.</p>		
<p>We are committed to ensuring that all music centre activities are accessible to all young people and provide subsidies for families who are eligible for the national Free School Meals scheme (for families receiving certain benefits) and for siblings of existing members.</p>		
<p>The music trust is responsible for the safety of students whilst they are within the music centre or on a pre-arranged visit or performance off-site and has appropriate Risk Assessment, Safeguarding, Health and Safety, and First Aid procedures in place. Parents must be responsible for their child's safety and well-being at all other times, with regard to their journey to and from the music centres.</p>

<p>Music centre members are expected to commit to all performance opportunities that are arranged for their groups and to approach their membership in a positive and professional manner.</p>
